The Municipality of Ramnicu Valcea

Ramnicu Valcea ("Ramnic") is the capital city of the Valcea County, Romania.

- -It has a population of 118.398 inhabitants; located in the South Western part of Romania, at 176 km far from Bucharest, the capital of Romania, 100 km far from Sibiu the 2007 European Capital of Culture;
- Ramnicu Valcea is a city close to UNESCO Heritage Monuments List: the Hurezi Monastery and the Horezu ceramics are situated at 50 km from Ramnicu Valcea,

in the city of Horezu.

Ramnicu Valcea's climate change mitigation

- The Ramnicu Valcea's climate change mitigation strategy refers to a Reliable, Clean and Efficient Energy City by putting into practice an important number of energy efficiency projects for the refurbishment of public and private buildings, in which are involved the public authority, the citizens and the citizens associations as well as private firms. Currently, the city have about 100 private buildings (block of flats) retrofitted with local/national/European funds.
 - Climate change mitigation projects: 3 park landscaping projects with European Funds, rehabilitation of public lightning with European funds, urban mobility projects (new, less polluted natural compressed gas buses for the public fleet).
 - 14,6 million Euros project (developed during 1999-2009 period with pre-UE adhesion funds) for the implementation of an integrated waste management system in town (new landfill in Feteni, compost station at Raureni, new waste selective system in town, information and awareness campaigns).
 - Aprox.500.000 Euros (2,5 million RON) funds from the local budget invested in the last 5 years in the City's waste selective collection system.
 - Waste selective collection campaigns in town developed with the Public Operator, with the ENVIRON and RECOLAMP associations (for the collection of electric and electronic waste from the population) and ECOTIC and The Institute
